

John Slavin Award 2011-12

BAFRA awards the John Slavin Trophy in odd-numbered years to the team with the best game management. This includes timely provision of appropriate chain crew and ball boys, provisions for spectators and spectator facilities and the provision of game balls in good condition. The title is awarded to the team that has comes out best in an audit carried out by BAFRA members at each game. A perfect facility scores 0.

The award is named after John Slavin. John was a long-serving BAFRA official and sometime director of the Association who sadly died in October 2005. In his memory, BAFRA has dedicated an award made to a team that shows commitment to improving the game experience for players and fans, as well as officials.
